IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS & INFORMATION

REQUIRED INFORMATION

Use of the attached "Petition for Variance" application is not required; however, its straight-forward questions are designed to help you provide sufficient details so that the District evaluator can quickly process your request.

If you elect to not use this application, Chapter 40D-1.1002 (4) specifies that your request must contain the following pieces of information:

- (A) The Petitioner's name, address, and telephone number;
- (B) The specific section of the rule or order from which the petitioner is requesting relief;
- (C) A detailed statement of the facts which the petitioner believes demonstrate that the request qualifies for a variance under Rule 40D-1.1002 (2), which may include reports by qualified technical experts;
- (D) A description of the relief desired;
- (E) The period of time for which the variance is sought, including the reasons and facts in support thereof;
- (F) The damage or harm resulting or which may result to petition from compliance with the rule or order;
- (G) The restrictions which petitioner can meet and the date when the petitioner can comply with such restrictions
- (H) A short-term water use reduction plan, describing any and all alternative reductions implemented in view of the restrictions for which variance is sought, if applicable;
- (I) The steps the petitioner is taking to meet the order or specific restrictions from which the variance is sought and when compliance will be achieved; and
- (J) Any other information the petitioner believes is material.

LIMITING CONDITIONS

The district may place limiting conditions on any variances it grants to you (such as requirement to install a rain gauge or sensor, or a maximum number of inches of water that can be applied during each supplemental irrigation cycle).

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS & INFORMATION, CONTINUED

CRITERIA FOR GRANTING PETITIONS

The criteria under which the District may grant a variance to you are as follows:

- (a) Alternative restrictions which achieve the same level of demand reduction are available, binding, and enforceable;
- b) The variance is essential to protect public health or safety;
- c) Compliance with the rule will require measures which, because of their extent or cost impose undue hardship, cannot be accomplished within the anticipated duration of the shortage, or will not ensure equitable distribution.

CURRENT RESTRICTIONS

Chapter 40D-21, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) is the Southwest Florida Water Management District's Water Shortage Rule. Each phase of a specific water shortage event, and any modifications to the corresponding set of restrictions contained in Chapter 40D-21, F.A.C., are declared through the use of District Order.

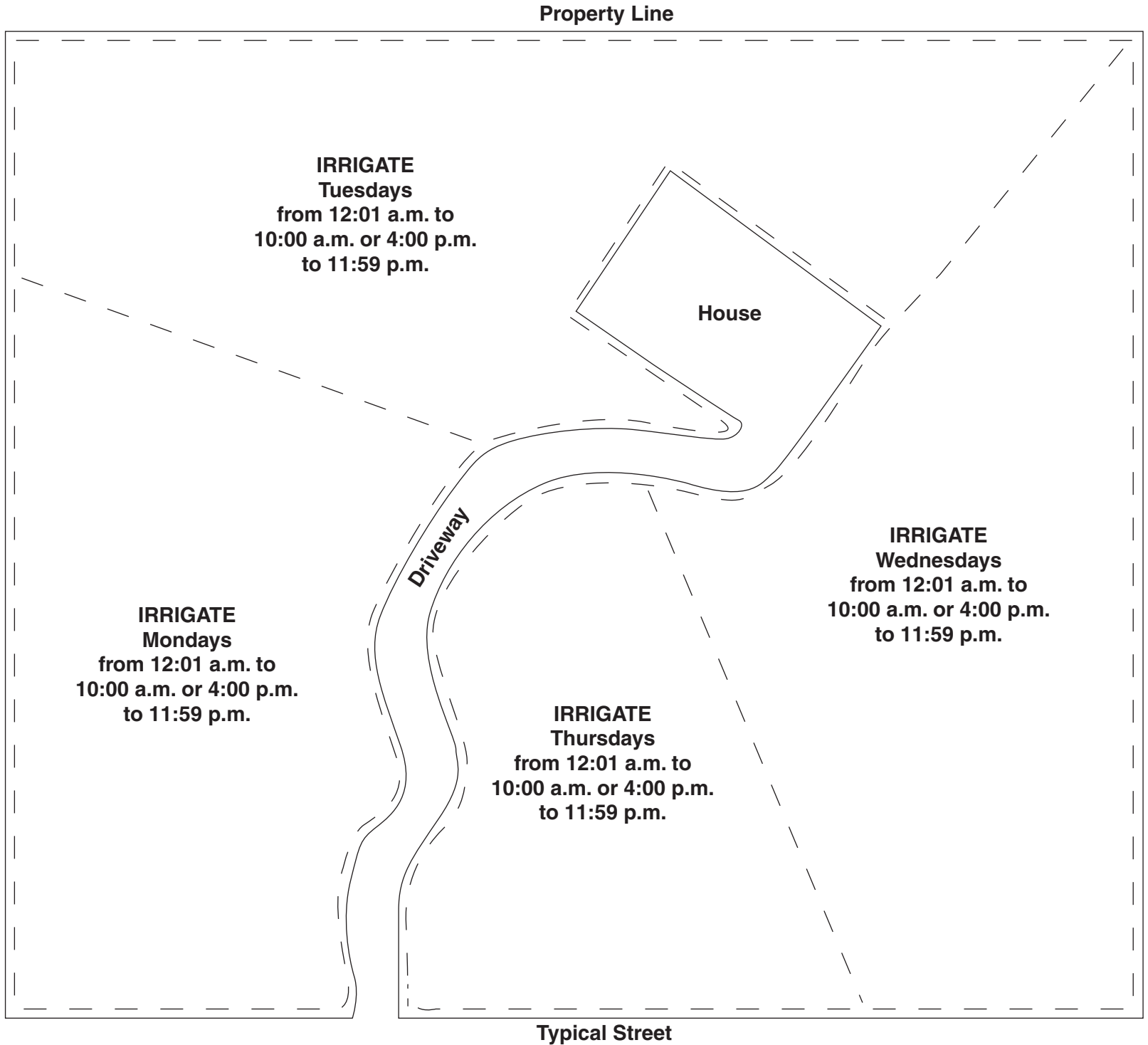
Please Note:
