

Residential Oil/Paint:

Residential oil, paint, solvents, pesticides, caulk, and other chemicals may be discarded at the Polk County North Central Landfill located at 7425 De Castro Rd Winter Haven Fl. 33880. This facility is open Monday - Friday 7:00 am to 5:00 pm, Saturday 7:30 am -12:30 pm. For questions please call (863) 284-4319.





Signs:

Garage sale and other signs cannot be placed in any city or state right-of-way. That includes signs on street signs, light poles, delineator posts, street lights, and trees.





Appliances:

Residents can dispose of appliances such as washers, dryers, dishwashers, and water heaters by placing item at curbside. For a small fee Refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners may also be taken to the Polk County North Central Landfill located at 7425 De Castro Rd Winter Haven Fl. 33880. This facility is open Monday -Friday 7:00 am to 5:00 pm, Saturday 7:30 am -12:30 pm. For questions please call (863) 284-4319.





Large Waste:

Large items not removable by your waste removal company need to be immediately and properly taken to Polk County North Central Landfill located at 7425 De Castro Rd Winter Haven Fl. 33880. This facility is open Monday -Friday 7:00 am to 5:00 pm, Saturday 7:30 am -12:30 pm. For questions please call (863) 284-4319.





Trash Containers:

All trash, garbage, and refuse must be bagged and placed in approved containers designed for the receipt of such materials. All containers shall have a tight fitting lids.

*Commercial dumpsters must be contained in a screened enclosure.





Vehicles/ Vessels:

All vehicles/vessels should be licensed and operable. There may be 1 unlicensed, inoperable, derelict vehicle/vessel on your property if covered with a fitted vehicle/vessel cover.





Tires can be recycled at the Polk County North Central Landfill located at 7425 De Castro Rd Winter Haven Fl. 33880. This facility is open Monday -Friday 7:00 am to 5:00 pm, Saturday 7:30 am -12:30 pm. For questions please call (863) 284-4319.. One way to avoid stock piling tires on your property is to let the tire dealership take them for disposal when new tires are installed on your vehicle.





Bushes/Trees:

Bushes, trees and shrubs need to be trimmed away from the sidewalk, streets, intersections, and alleys to allow for unobstructed vehicle and pedestrian traffic, and clear view. Trees that overhang streets and alleys must be trimmed to 14' above the street or alley and Trees that overhang the sidewalk must be trimmed to 8' above the sidewalk.





Green Waste:

Tree branches, limbs, lawn clippings, leaves, and other yard waste may be disposed of by placing item at curbside or for a small fee may be taken to Polk County North Central Landfill located at 7425 De Castro Rd Winter Haven Fl. 33880. This facility is open Monday -Friday 7:00 am to 5:00 pm, Saturday 7:30 am -12:30 pm. For questions please call (863) 284-4319.



Premises Identification:

Buildings shall have approved address numbers placed in a position to be plainly legible and visible from the street or road fronting the property. These numbers shall contrast with their background. Address numbers shall be Arabic numerals or alphabetic letters.

- a) **Residential** property address numbers shall be a minimum of four (4) inches (102 mm) high with a minimum one-half (.5) inch (12.7 mm) stroke width.
- b) **Commercial** property address numbers shall be a minimum of six (6) inches (152.4mm)high with a minimum one-half (.5) inch (12.7 mm) stroke width.





Weeds, dandelions, tall grass and offensive growth must be below 12 inches high. Therefore, it is necessary for residents and property owners to regularly cut the weeds on their property, which includes vacant lots, alleys and sidewalk areas surrounding their property.

Junk & Trash Removal:

Any person in control of private property is required to maintain the premises, keep alley and sidewalk areas free and clear of litter and debris. All trash must be bagged and tied shut, to prevent litter when garbage cans are emptied or blown over by the wind.
